Welcome to Arlington Rural Banter.

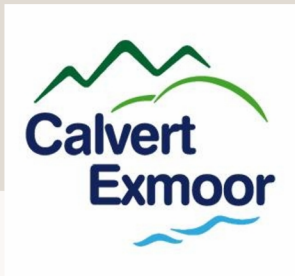

The recent £550,000 fundraising campaign by Calvert Trust Exmoor has been successful, enabling the Trust to continue its invaluable provision of activities for disabled people of all ages. Two new Trustees have been appointed to replace others who have resigned , with a view to reinvigorating the board. The new Trustees are Jamie Morris, with a background in the holiday and property sector and Glyn Brackenbury who has spent his career in and around activity centres.

Over 2200 individuals and businesses contributed to the fundraising. More details of the restructuring will be made available soon, but we understand the Trust wish to keep the horses safe on site and invest in new bunkhouse accommodation.

Locals who contributed will be given a guided tour of the centre in November, with the activities being explained - and given their chance to have a go at archery!
